Introduction

At Jubilee Church Derby, we collect different types of information about our users for the following main reasons:

- To be able to communicate with users by email and other means.
- To be able to register users into events
- To be able to collect donations and claim gift aid
- To help us improve the service we offer

Our Principles

We are absolutely committed to protecting your privacy. Our policy can be summarised in one sentence: *we will not share your information with others without your consent.*

We have established the following two principles:

- We will respect your email privacy. You will only receive email from Jubilee in relation to Jubilee, ChristCentral or Newfrontiers matters e.g. latest news, future events, funding opportunities etc.

- We will not share any individual user details (including your email address) to any third party without your consent.

What data we gather

We collect information on our users through email sign-up, contact forms, donation forms and/or registration at an event.

We may collect the following information:

- Name
- Contact information including email address
- Website usage data
- Other information relevant to enquiries
- Other information pertaining to specific events or surveys
 - For email sign-up and contact forms we keep the minimum information needed to identify you and be able to communicate with you.
 - For registration, we ask for information necessary for event badges, payment confirmation i.e. name and address, dietary needs and contact details.
 - For donations, we keep the minimum information necessary to verify payments and claim gift aid.

How we use this data

Collecting this data helps us understand what you are looking for from us, enabling us to deliver improved products and services.

Specifically, we may use data:

- For our own internal records
- To improve the services we provide
- To contact you in response to a specific enquiry
- To customise the website for you
- To send you promotional emails about events, services, offers and things we think may be relevant to you
- To send promotional mailings or to call you about events, services, offers and other things we think might be relevant to you
- Occasionally we may contact you via email, telephone or mail for research reasons

Who will have access to your information?

By default, your personal information will be visible to our internal, authenticated users of the site. Such personnel are only allowed to use that data for Jubilee purposes. They are not allowed to transfer it to another organisation.

Remember to close your browser when you have finished your user session. This is to ensure that others cannot access your personal information and correspondence if you share a computer with someone else or are using a computer in a public place like a library or Internet cafe. You as an individual are responsible for the security of, and access to, your own computer.

Please be aware that whenever you voluntarily disclose personal information over the Internet that this information can be collected and used by others. In short, if you post personal information in publicly accessible online forums, you may receive unsolicited messages from other parties in return. Ultimately, you are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your information. Please be careful and responsible whenever you are using the Internet.

We will never lease, distribute, or sell your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission or the law requires us to.

To prevent unauthorised disclosure or access to your information, we have implemented strong physical and electronic security safeguards.

We also follow stringent procedures to ensure we work with all personal data in line with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Cookies and how we use them

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file placed on your computer's hard drive. It enables our website to identify your computer as you view different pages on our website.

Cookies allow websites and applications to store your preferences in order to present content, options or functions that are specific to you. They also enable us to see information like how many people use the website and what pages they tend to visit.

We use cookies on this website to track user activity on the site and to enable various types of functionality. While we will endeavour to keep the list below updated, the site relies on many third-party services and the list may therefore become out of date if those services alter the cookies they use. Please note that all of these Cookies exist to enable functionality on the website and not for advertising purposes.

How we use cookies

We may use cookies to:

- **Analyse our web traffic using an analytics package.** Aggregated usage data helps us improve the website structure, design, content and functions.

- **Identify whether you are signed into our website.** A cookie allows us to check whether you are signed into our site.
- **Store information about your preferences.** The website can then present you with information you will find more relevant and interesting.
- **To recognise when you return to our website.** We may show your relevant content, or provide functionality you used previously.

There are two types of cookie you may encounter when using this website:

First party cookies: these are our own cookies, controlled by us and used to provide information about usage of our site.

Third party cookies: these are cookies found in other companies' internet tools which we are using to enhance our site, for example Facebook, Twitter and Google have their own cookies, which are controlled by them.

Controlling Cookies

You can use your web browser's cookie settings to determine how our website uses cookies. If you do not want our website to store cookies on your computer or device, you should set your web browser to refuse cookies.

However, please note that doing this may affect how our website functions. Some pages and services may become unavailable to you.

Unless you have changed your browser to refuse cookies, our website will issue cookies when you visit it.
