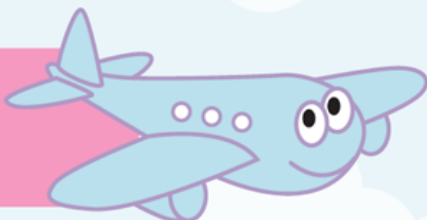


Flying start for 2 year olds

You can claim a free place for your child if you receive one or more of the following:

- **Income Support (IS)**
- **Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance (JSA)**
- **Employment Support Allowance (ESA)**
- **National Asylum Support Service (NASS)**
- **Pension Credit**
- **Child Tax Credit** where income is £16,190 or less and you are not entitled to claim Working Tax Credit
- **or the child is looked after by Derby City Council.**

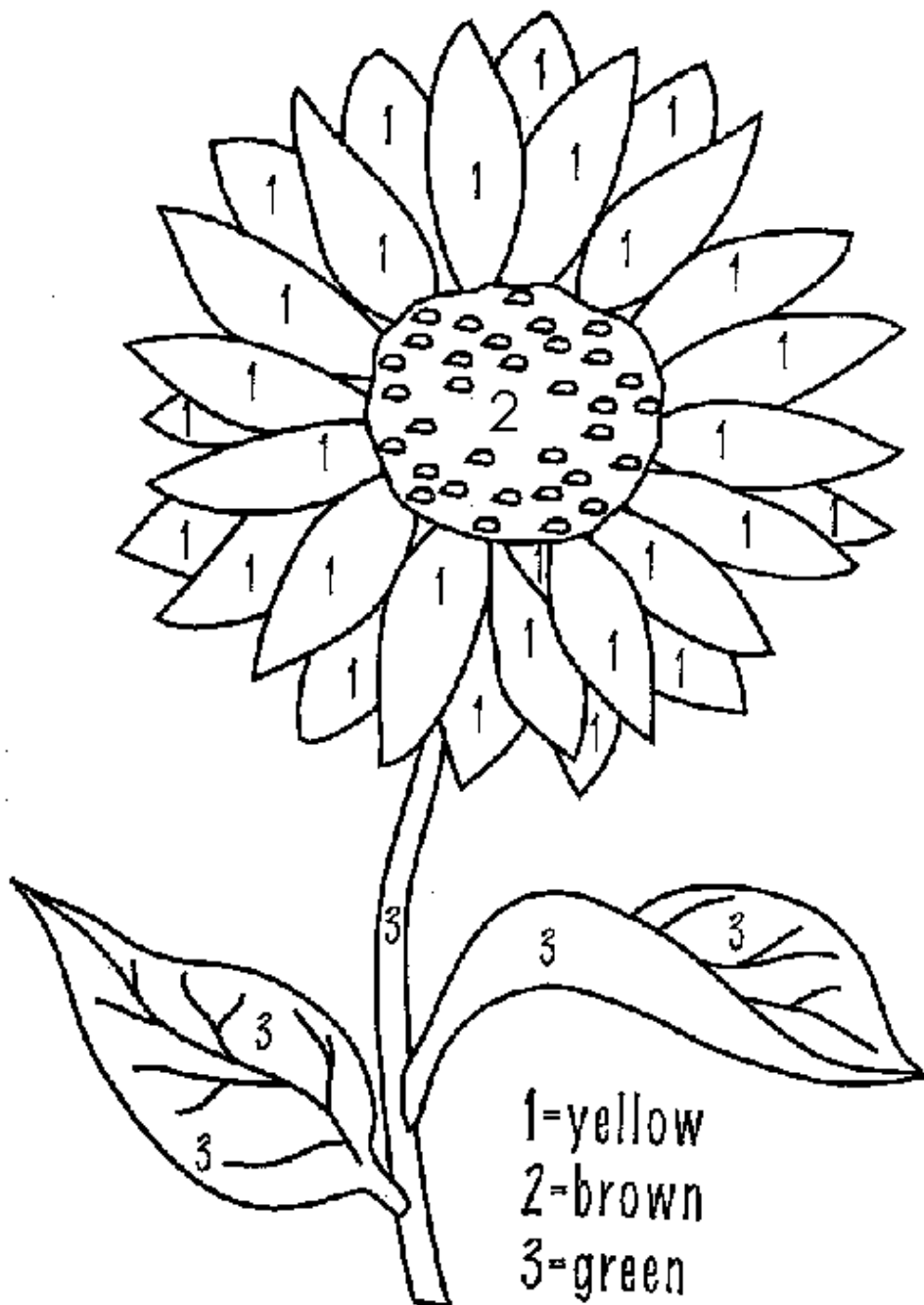
